

# **BEECHER PRIVACY POLICY**

Beecher Investors is committed to protecting the privacy of our current, prospective and former clients. We view the responsibility of safeguarding your personal information as an essential characteristic of any business interested in being viewed as an outstanding service organization. ## **Your Privacy Is Not for Sale**

Simply put, we do not and will not sell your personal information to anyone for any reason, at any time.

## **Information We Collect**

We collect information about you by keeping records from our meetings and conversations, by keeping copies of your letters or faxes to us, by the various applications that you fill out to hire our services, from information you provide to our web site, and by collecting information about you from certain third party vendors, e.g., consumer reporting agencies.

## **How We Share Information**

Within Beecher, we share information about you among our employees, as well as certain carefully screened suppliers such as our corporate counsel and auditors. We may also share information with service providers that you employ and introduce to us such as your family office, personal accountant or counsel.

## **Complying With The Law**

We will comply with State and Federal laws that apply to the disclosure of information about you.

## **How to Limit The Sharing of Information About You**

Under the law, you may choose to limit the information we disclose about you to outside companies, however, we already voluntarily enforce these limitations. For example, you may instruct us to: (1) not to share information used to determine your eligibility for credit; (2) not to share information about you with an outside company for joint marketing purposes. However, by policy we do not do either of these two things except in response to your request.

## **How We Safeguard Your Information**

We take precautions to protect your information. Our employees are trained about privacy and required via a confidentiality agreement to safeguard personal information. We maintain physical, electronic and procedural safeguards to protect personal information. Companies or individuals we hire are not allowed to use information about our clients for their own purposes and are contractually obligated to maintain strict confidentiality.
